What is an Ohio Realtors District Vice President?

- -There are currently 5 District within the Ohio Realtors. Each local board is assigned a district given their logistics. SBOR sits in District 5 along with: Butler-Warren, Cincinnati Area, Clinton County, Dayton REALTORS, Midwestern Ohio & Southern Ohio. Each District has 2 DVP Representatives, typically 1 from the South & 1 from the Northern sector of the district. The term is 2 calendar years. My DVP partner is Rachel Lewitt from Butler-Warren Board.
- -Our duties include: Visit the Member Boards in the district as much as necessary. Assist in the organization of New Boards and perform such other duties as; installation of board officers, or any other assigned duties given by the Ohio Realtors President and Board of Directors. Attend all State meetings of the Association, its Executive Committee (the DVP position is also an executive officer) and Board of Directors. Basically, the FACE of the Ohio Realtors!
- -With all of the above being said, I will have the ability to bring SBOR and its members up to speed with current & on going information that will be VALUABLE to you.
